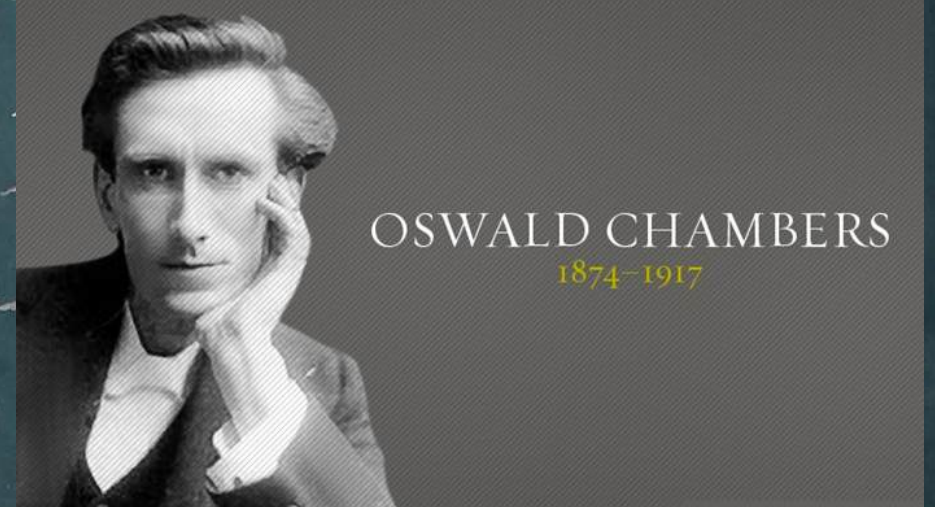

The English Standard Version on the Bible.is app



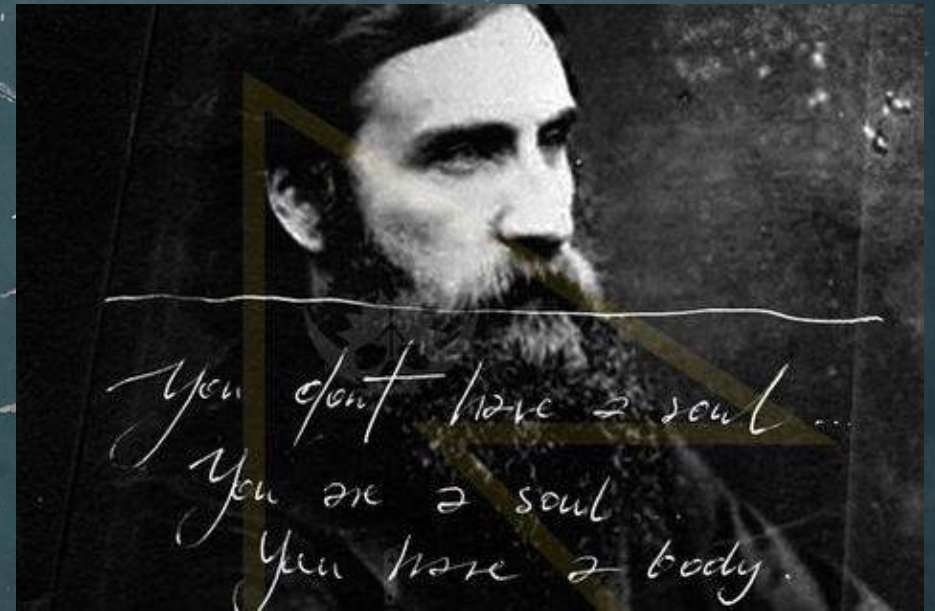
The *ESV* is my go-to. Created by a team of more than 100 leading evangelical scholars and pastors, it's a word-for-word translation of the Bible into contemporary English.

George MacDonald's words inspired the likes of G.K. Chesterton, J.R.R. Tolkien, Madeleine L'Engle, and C.S. Lewis.

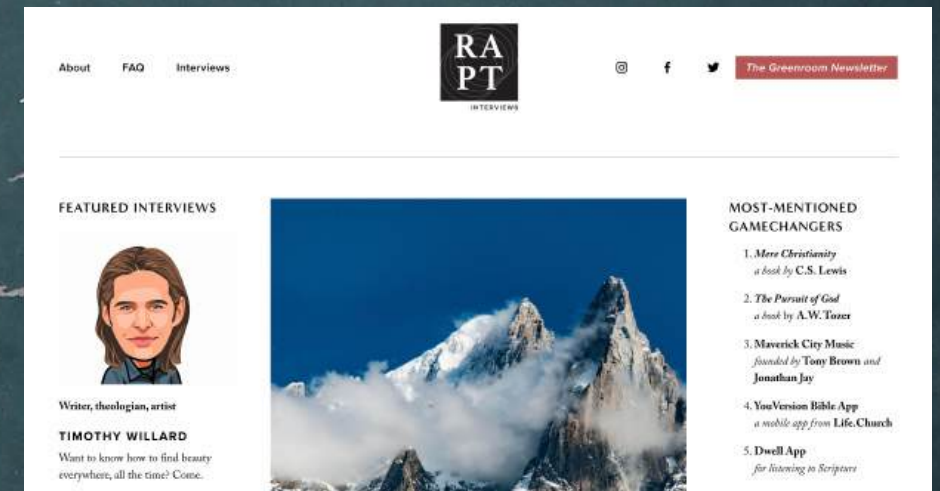

by Brennan Manning



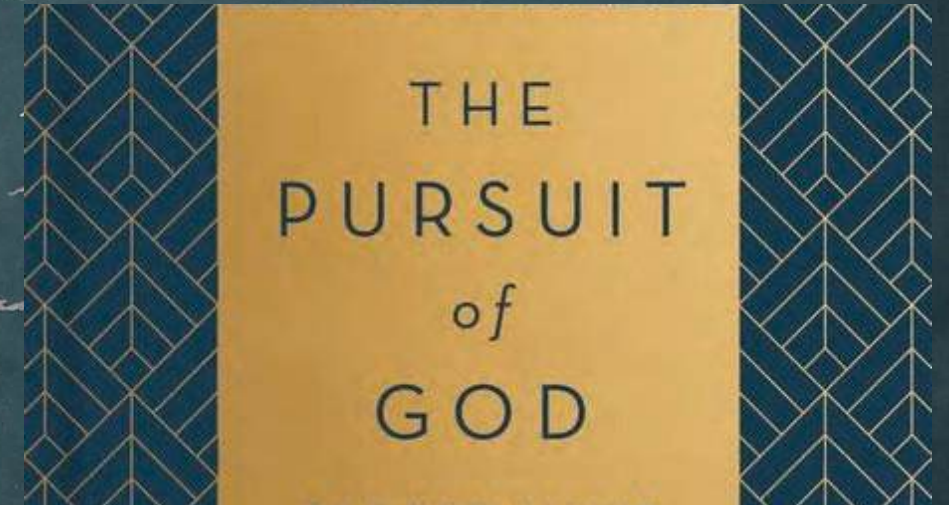

from Frank Darabont



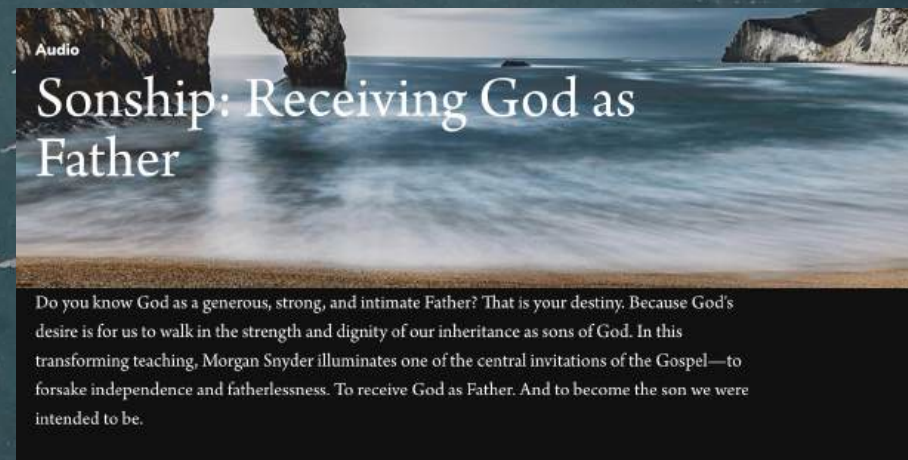

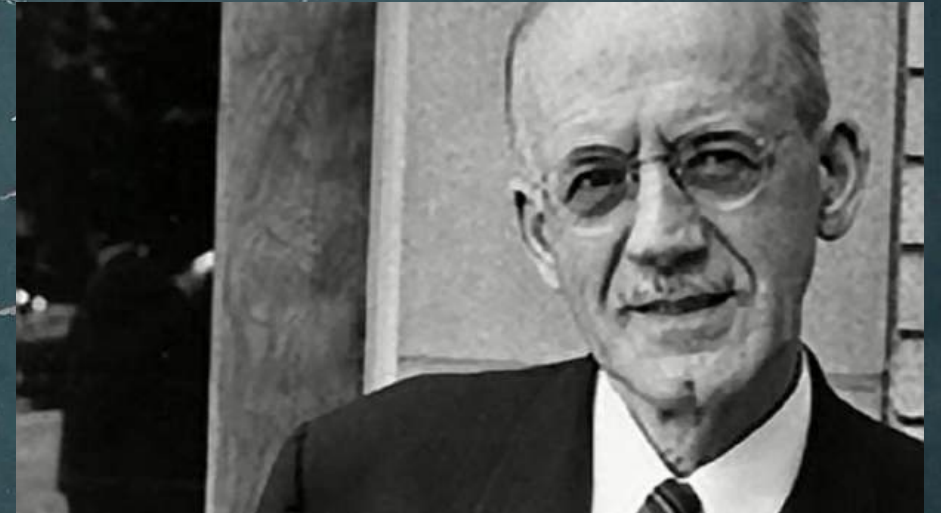

Old Sermons from Charles Spurgeon



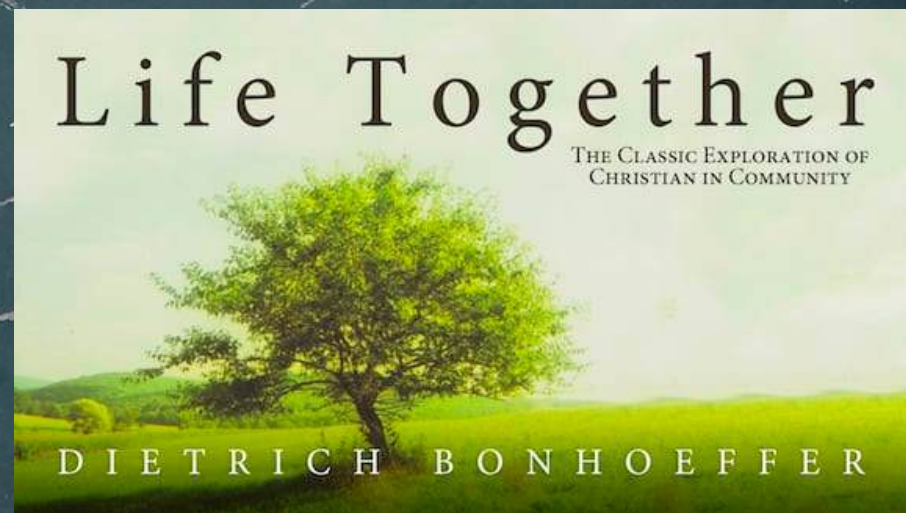

I encountered this prayer in preparation for a trip to Ireland. I was taken by its beauty and boldness; I still am.

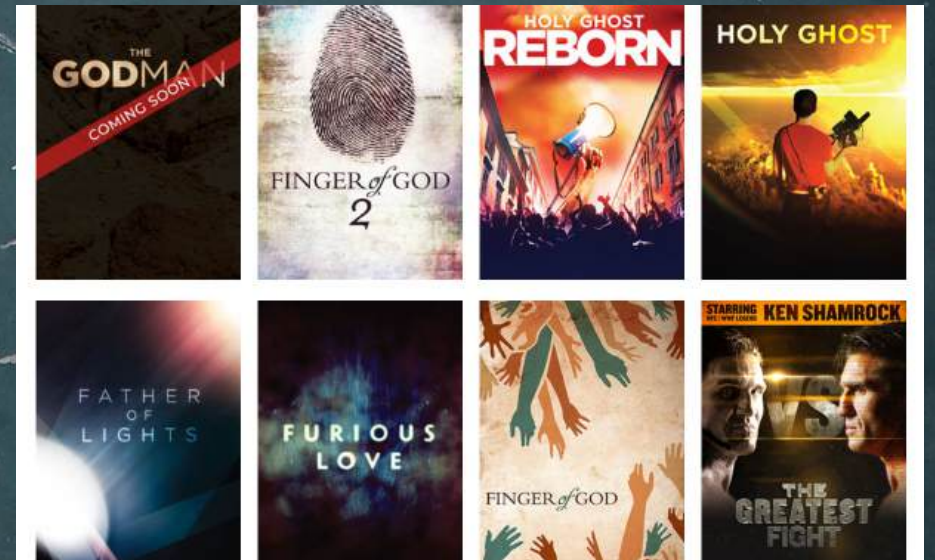
