







The *ESV* is my go-to. Created by a team of more than 100 leading evangelical scholars and pastors, it's a word-for-word translation of the Bible into contemporary English.





So that I never have to worry about jotting down an old school, handwritten note whenever and wherever inspiration strikes, I also make a Fisher Space Pen part of my everyday carry.




Death, sacrifice, resurrection, mercy, repentance, salvation, justice, fellowship—they're all in there. I wish I could read it again for the first time.




This crazy good song was the starting place for my personal journey into understanding sonship.





#### Sonship: Receiving God as Father



This study is a *must do*.







